

PO phase Evaluation by Clusters experts Non exhaustive list of evaluation criteria

- Criteria are:
 - ✓ Rationale of the project
 - ✓ Technology & innovation
 - ✓ Market & impact
 - ✓ Consortium overview
 - ✓ Partner contribution











PO phase

- PO submission deadline
- Evaluation by Clusters technical experts
 - Evaluation of technical experts can be used at national level
- Evaluation by PAs:
 - Eligibility of partners incl financial viability, obligatory or recommended improvements to revise project and raise chance for funding
 - Exchange amongst PAs about the most promising projects
- Joint meeting PAs, expert(s) and Cluster office discussion and agreement about projects to be invited to FPP

Non exhaustive list of evaluation criteria

- Additional criteria are:
 - ✓ Work package description
 - ✓ Have the recommendations of Cluster experts and PAs been taken into account?











FPP phase

- FPP submission deadline
- Evaluation by technical experts
 - PAs can accept Cluster evaluation (completely or partly) if they like, instead of performing a national evaluation
- Evaluation by PAs:
 - Eligibility of partners incl. financial viability (in case new partners have been added) obligatory or recommended improvements to be implemented in national application.
 - Exchange amongst PAs about the projects to be labelled and funded to align
- Joint meeting PAs, expert(s) and Cluster office discussion and suggestion for projects to be labelled and funded
- Project labelling by Clusters
- Submission of national application according to national rules (can be requested earlier)
- Projects should start latest 12 months after FPP submission deadline

- Access to evaluation by technical experts. PAs can accept Cluster evaluation (completely or partly) if they like, instead of performing a national evaluation

Monitoring phase

- Two levels
 - ✓ National requirements
 - ✓ Cluster offices process
- Face-to-Face meetings, checklists, written reports and final review
- Final report and impact summary











Change request

- Flexibility to implement changes at any stage of the project execution
- Already before start of project possible, to implement recommendations after FPP submission
- Approval of changes in agreement with Cluster technical experts and PAs
