EUREKA is a major tool for cross border cooperation: Over 30 billion euro in investment over 27 years, more than 17,000 organizations participating in over 4,000 projects


> There are three different types of EUREKA instruments






Bottom-up, they reflect market demands

Market oriented, their objective is to develop a product, a process or a service

- \succ A joint EUREKA-EU funding and support programme for R&D-performing SMEs
- \succ Small, short-term projects, involving participants from at least two Eurostars participating countries
- Consortium leader is an R&D-performing SME
- \succ Go for an Eurostars project if you are a small company with an important high-tech component and you want to lead your own project

The Eurostars Programme is powered by EUREKA and the European Community











- > Medium-term, strategically-significant initiatives

- 40 months duration






EUREKA projects are funded through national public expenditure


