#### What did we do?

- The new broadband standard in the DSLseries: G.fast. Up to 1 Gbits/second
- We initiated the G.fast standard in 2011
- Standard completed 2014 (1<sup>st</sup> version)
- We wrote more than 400 standards papers
- Market value about 10.000.000.000 Euro
- Many partners are self-funded (i.e. they pay to be in the project)
