- CDTI way of work in Clusters
  - Coordination with SETSI
  - Participation in Public Authorities Boards
  - Promotion at national level
  - Advice participants: applications and funding
  - Technology blind: bottom-up approach
  - Spain has to be a reference in the projects
  - Projects should be strategic and tackle grand challenges
  - Synergies with other European programs expected: FI, 5G
