


## Organisation Profile




- Mesensei develops mobile platform as a service (m-PaaS) technology used by Municipality of Nurmijärvi as the lead customer for its Regional Readiness Center
- Since 2018, Mesensei has invested 1.5 million in product development in revenue and investments. The platform is used by universities, municipalities, NGO's and corporates for building privacy and data protection sensitive digital services.















## Proposal Introduction: Idea



**Vision:** Bridge the critical gap between everyday civil defense preparedness and mission-critical crisis response through a dual-use platform that makes preparedness affordable and scalable.

**Motivation:** Municipalities report authority systems being too complex and expensive, while everyday tools are inadequate for compliance. SHIELD solves this with a platform that's cost-effective for training and is capable of transforming into a mission critical system with hardened reliability, security and features.

- **Dual-Use Architecture:** Training and simulation system starting from €2000/year per municipality
- Public-Private Integration: Connects volunteers, NGOs, and authorities on unified platform
- Real-World Validation: Built on proven Regional Readiness Center model in Nurmijärvi

**Innovation:** First platform to solve the preparedness-response cost paradox by optimizing for municipal budgets during peacetime while ensuring operational capability during crises

## Outcomes & Impact



#### **Expected Outcomes:**

- Civil Defense Platform: Interoperable system for 17,500 EU municipalities
- 85% Base Cost Reduction: Compared to mixed use of miscellaneous systems and field training costs
- Upsales for advanced capabilities: API architecture, marketplace and ecosystem for plug&play and on-demand capabilities

#### **Market Impact:**

- €44M Annual Revenue Potential by Year 7 (17,500 municipalities × €2,500 average)
- 10x-30x ROI for technology partners through established user base integration
- First-Mover Advantage in capturing regional crisis management market

#### **Schedule: 36-Month Project Duration**

- Year 1: Nurmijärvi co-creation and Finnish national solution
- Year 2: Nordic/Baltic rollouts
