- Open to any organization willing to contribute to industry-driven ICT research and innovation collaborative projects
- 1000 private and public organisations:
 - large industry players
 - small & medium-sized enterprises (40% of programme participation)
 - academic/research institutions
- Several Calls per year, including joint calls with other clusters

Bottom-up

Proposers are free to define their project proposal according to their own research interests.



So far projects have led to more than 1050 new or improved products and services.

High Success Rate

High-quality proposals have a good chance of receiving funding.

Average success rate 60 %.

Flexibility

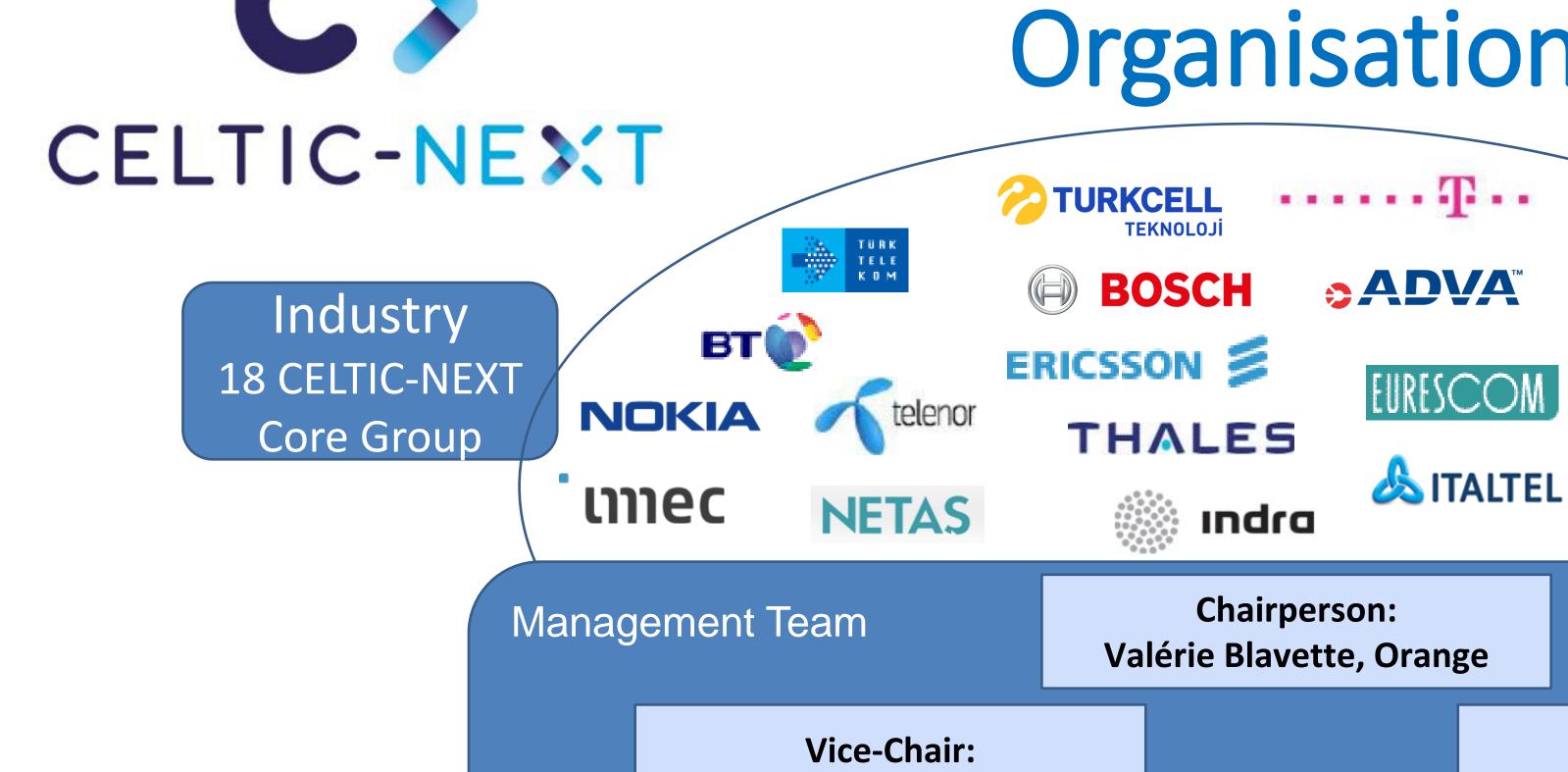
Project focus can be adjusted to new technological developments in the field.
